

There are 70 boys playing football across four divisions, and 55 boys across three hurling divisions, supported by a team of 16 coaches.

The BSJ1 hurlers & footballers both achieved Division 1 status, so bright days ahead for BSJ.

What you need to know!

- Entry open to members & non-members of BSJ GAA Club
- MAI will be played under the GoGames ethos (Respect, Participation, Fun, Learning & Friendship)

• Teams will be mixed ability and picked in advance of the start of the competition

• We will have separate competitions for each age group from Under 6 (2017) to Under 12 (2011)

• We will try and make sure we have no subs so depending on numbers entering some teams might have 1 extra player

- Teams will hopefully be managed by players from the U12/U13/U14 teams
- Games will be refereed by some of our young official referees & TY students

• All players will receive their own county t-shirt to keep and must be worn each night

- At the end of the week all players will receive a Sliotar (Hurling & Camogie) or Football (Football & Ladies Football)
- To avoid confusion we will have the same scoring system for all age groups (traditional Goals = 3pts, Over the crossbar = 1pt)



Key Days & Dates

Week 1 - Hurling & Camogie competitions, Monday 29th May to Friday 2nd June

- Camogie will take place Mon 29th, Wed 31st & Friday 2nd June
- Hurling will take place Tuesday 30th, Thursday 1st & Friday 2nd June
- Under 12 to Under 9 in Camogie will have 5 games (20 min games) across the 3 nights
- Under 12 to Under 8 will have 5 games (20 min games) across the 3 nights in Hurling
- Teams will 2 games on the 1st night, 2 games on the 2nd night & 1 game on the final night (finale match)
- Under 7 & Under 6 will have 3 games across 2 nights, Camogie Under 8 will also have 3 games across 2 nights
- * Camogie U8, U7 & U6 will have 2 games on Wed 31st & 1 game on Fri 2nd
- ** Hurling U7 & U6 will have 2 games on Tuesday 30th & 1 game on Fri 2nd

Week 2 - Football & Ladies Football competitions, Tuesday 6th June to Saturday 10th June

- Football will take place Tues 6th June, Thurs 8th & Saturday 10th June in the afternoon
- Ladies Football will take place Wed 7th, Fri 9th & Saturday 10th June in the afternoon
- Under 12 to Under 8 will have 5 games (20 min games) across the 3 nights , U12 to U9 in Ladies Football
- *Teams will 2 games on the 1st night, 2 games on the 2nd night & 1 game on the final afternoon (finale match)
- Under 7 & Under 6 will have 3 games across 2 nights, Ladies Football will also have 3 games across 2 nights/days
- * Football U7 & U6 will have 2 games on Thurs 8th & 1 game on Saturday 10th June in the afternoon
- **Ladies Football U8, U7 & U6 will have 2 games on Wed 7th & 1 game on Saturday 10th June in the afternoon



What you need to know!

All Matches will be played beside the clubhouse in Marlay Pk on 6-8 mini pitches each evening.

The matches will start from 5pm/5.20pm and run until 7pm/7.30pm. In general we will start with the younger age groups in the early slots and finish with the older age groups in the later slots.

You will only need to be present for the times of your matches (5 or 3 x 20min games over 3 / 2 nights).


